

CHAPTER SIX – READING RESOURCES

Reading Skill	Activity
Retrieval	<p>What were the names of the fairies that had visited Poppy? What sort of fairies were they? (p35) The fairies were called Gullveig and Jareth, they were Tooth Fairies.</p> <p>How long had they been Tooth Fairies? (p35) 436 years, 4 months, 1 week and a day.</p> <p>Why were Poppy, Lord Ted, Gullveig and Jareth trying to be quiet? (p36) They were trying to be quiet so that they didn't wake Jack/the cockerel up.</p> <p>Where had Poppy's teeth landed? Who fetched which tooth? (p37) One was behind her bag (Gullveig) and one was under her camp bed (Jareth).</p> <p>How old were the tooth fairies? (p37) Gullveig – 474 years old; Jareth – 475 years old</p> <p>How is Nanny described on page 38? She is described as 'a little bit parent, a little bit teacher, a little bit best friend and a little bit partner in crime.'</p> <p>What had the tooth fairies left in place of Poppy's teeth? (p38) Two, pound coins, one for each tooth.</p> <p>What did Grandpa ask Poppy to do after they had unpacked the car at home? (p40) He asked her to help him water the garden.</p>
Inference	<p>How do you think Poppy felt when she met the tooth fairies?</p> <p>How do you think the tooth fairies felt when they woke Poppy up?</p>
Vocabulary	<p>Create your own funny argument – what words and phrase would you use to show this was amusing and an argument?</p>



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Summary	<p>Explain what Gullveig and Jareth were arguing over and why? (35/36) <i>They were arguing over whose fault it was that the tissue containing Poppy's teeth had ripped and where her teeth had ended up.</i></p> <p>Summarise what had happened during the night. Did it really happen to Poppy, or do you think it was a dream? Give reasons for your answer.</p> <p>Poppy has arrived home after her holiday with Nanny, Grandpa and Lord Ted. She doesn't want to forget anything. Write a summary of the events of the chapter.</p>
Prediction	<p>Read the first three lines on p35. What do you think is happening?</p> <p>What would you want to be behind the crooked door? Write a description of what you would find when you opened the door and give reasons for your choices.</p>
Author	<p>Why do you think the author decided to make these characters argue all the time?</p>
